Bylaws of Rolling Horizons, Inc.

Article I: Name & Purpose

- 1. The name of the organization shall be **Rolling Horizons, Inc.**
- 2. Rolling Horizons is a **501(c)(3) nonprofit** dedicated to **empowering youth through** cycling, trail stewardship, and outdoor adventure.

Article II: Membership

- 1. Membership is open to all individuals, families, and organizations who support the mission of RH.
- 2. Members may participate in **events, training programs, and volunteer opportunities.**
- 3. Youth members (under 18) can participate in the Youth Leadership Council (YLC) and serve in leadership roles.

Article III: Governance

1. Board of Directors:

- The Board shall consist of 10-15 members, including youth representatives.
- o Board members serve **2-year terms** with eligibility for reappointment.
- The President, Vice President, Treasurer, and Secretary form the Executive
 Committee.
- o The Board shall meet at least **quarterly** to oversee operations and strategy.

2. Committees:

- Standing committees include Programs & Education, Trails &
 Stewardship, Events & Races, Marketing & Media, and Fundraising &
 Sponsorship.
- o Ad hoc committees may be created as needed.

3. Youth Leadership Council:

- The YLC serves as a bridge between youth participants and the Board of Directors.
- Youth members in leadership roles may attend board meetings and participate in decision-making.

Article IV: Decision-Making & Voting

- 1. Board decisions require a simple majority vote.
- 2. The **YLC** has advisory voting rights, meaning their recommendations are formally considered.
- 3. A quorum (at least 51% of board members) is required for official votes.

Article V: Financial Management

- 1. The Treasurer oversees **budgets**, **fundraising**, **and grant management**.
- 2. Annual budgets must be approved by the Board.
- 3. **Rolling Horizons shall not operate for profit.** All funds must support the mission and programs.

Article VI: Partnerships & Collaboration

- 1. RH may form collaborations with schools, local businesses, outdoor organizations, and environmental groups.
- 2. Any formal agreements must be reviewed and approved by the Board.

Article VII: Amendments

- 1. Amendments to these bylaws may be proposed by any board member.
- 2. Proposed amendments must be approved by 3/3 of the Board before adoption.
